

# The Chancellor's Awards for Excellence in Undergraduate Research

**Nomination deadline: April 9, 2018**

**Presented annually to distinguished undergraduate researchers in three disciplinary fields and to one faculty member who has made extraordinary contributions to UCSB's undergraduate research mission**

The purpose of these awards is twofold: to recognize students and faculty who have successfully applied themselves in this area; and to increase the visibility of undergraduate research opportunities as an enhancement to the overall educational experience.

Recipients will be honored during the spring commencement ceremonies with a certificate of recognition and a monetary award. Each academic department, program, and organized research unit is invited to nominate one graduating senior and one faculty member. Previous awardees are not eligible (see list). Selections are made by the Academic Senate Committee on Undergraduate Student Affairs.
