WHAT IS THE TRANSFER STUDENT RESEARCH AWARD?

The Transfer Student Research Award provides support for transfer students to engage in research activities that can benefit from funding. Awards are available both for graduating senior transfer students and continuing junior transfer students. The maximum award is **\$750** per project. Funds may cover project expenses beginning in Spring quarter, through Summer, and up to the end of Fall quarter.

The deadline to submit a TSRA proposal is **March 1, 2016**.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for the Transfer Student Research Award, you must:

- Be a UCSB undergraduate transfer student admitted as a junior.
- Be in good academic standing and remain so throughout the funding period.
- Be currently engaged in a research project, or planning to initiate one. (Grants are NOT awarded retroactively for completed projects.)
- Identify a faculty member who is willing to supervise your project before applying.
- Have not already received funding via an Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities (URCA) grant for the current year.
